

Tri-State Season High Points Awards

All current Tri-State nominated horses and Equitation, Academy & Open Schooling riders are eligible to compete for year-end High Points awards. The awards are based on performance at Tri-State Affiliated Shows throughout the season. The awards for Champion and Reserve Champion in each qualifying class are presented at the Annual Tri-State Banquet at the end of the show season.

The qualifying class and division descriptions are detailed in the Tri-State Approved Class Specifications & Divisions for Season Championship document.

General Requirements & Computation of Points

- 1. Tri-State member horses and/or riders will be eligible to earn points <u>after</u> paying the required nomination and membership fees.
- 2. Horse or rider must show and place in the same approved Tri-State class in at least three (3) different shows under two (2) different judges to be eligible for championships.
- 3. Points will be counted as follows:

$$1^{st} = 20$$
 $4^{th} = 8$
 $2^{nd} = 16$ $5^{th} = 4$

$$3^{rd} = 12$$
 $6^{th} = 1$

- 4. Half points will be counted for any class in any show with less than three horses entered and shown. (e.g. 1st = 10 pts; 2nd = 8 pts, etc.).
- 5. In the event of a year-end tie, awards will be given to both competitors.
