All Tri-State members 17 and under, either competing or non-competing, are qualified to participate in this program. They will be recognized at the Annual Awards & Recognition Banquet held at the end of the season where team patches will be awarded.

Awards are based on completing both Horsemanship and Volunteer activities throughout the show season. Hours completed after the end of the current show season may be reported in the following season.

♦ Horsemanship Activity Log Requirements

Non-Competing Youth requires 20 hours
Academy/Schooling Youth requires 30 hours
Performance/Equitation Youth requires 60 hours

Horsemanship hours may include any of these equine activities:

Lessons Grooming & Tacking Riding & Driving Show Ring Time

Training & Lunging

Log Volunteer Activity Log Requirements

Non-Competing Youth requires 10 hours
Academy/Schooling Youth requires 20 hours
Performance/Equitation Youth requires 30 hours

Volunteer hours may include any equine or community activities such as:

Gates/ribbons Pet Sitting
Show set up Dog Walking

School, Church, Food Shelf, or other Community Charitable Organizations

♦ Competition Requirements

Academy/Schooling & Performance/Equitation riders must also compete in a minimum of 3 Tri-State approved shows during the current season.
